



MUNDELEIN RECYCLES!

Curbside recycling is provided to all Mundelein residents for the very nominal fee of \$2.15 per month. Businesses also have the opportunity to participate in the recycling program by calling Mundelein Disposal at (847) 566-5159 to sign up.

The following items are accepted: Plastic coded #1-7; aluminum, metal, and aerosol cans; newspaper; office paper; junk mail; cardboard; chipboard (cereal and food boxes); telephone books; magazines; paper bags; six-pack rings; and glass jars and bottles.

Preparation Tips:

- Rinse or clean containers
- Crush or flatten materials before recycling
- Plastic wrap is NOT recyclable
- To save space use the recycling bin for all non-paper items and prepare paper items as indicated

Put newspapers in a brown paper bag and place on top of, or next to, your bin. Try not to mix other recyclable paper products with newspapers.

Place all paper products (mixed paper, chipboard, cardboard, magazines, mail, etc.) in a separate brown bag. Place bag on top of or next to your bin. Cardboard that does not fit in a paper bag must be cut into pieces no larger than 2'x2' in size and tied with string. Place cardboard on the ground next to, or on top of, your bin.
