Modeled after the Illinois Department of Transportation (I.D.O.T.) and Lake County Division of Transportation (L.C.D.O.T.) Additionally, Mundelein's Public Works and Engineering Department must complete a policy information and safety guidelines meeting with each participating group coordinator prior to the first collection activity.

Adopt-A-Roadway - Program Policy and Safety Guidelines

It is the policy of the Village of Mundelein's Adopt-A-Roadway Program to promote participation by residents, community groups, not-for-profit organizations and private firms in the voluntary beautification of public right-of-way within our community. The policy and safety information is as follows:

1. Participation is limited to individuals or groups as defined within the Village of Mundelein's policy, with the following amendments.
 - a. A private firm or company can only be considered for adoption of roadway sections located within the Village of Mundelein with this packet, (State and County sections of roadways are under the jurisdictions of the Illinois Department of Transportation (I.D.O.T.) and Lake County Department of Transportation (L.C.D.O.T.) Adopt-A-Highway Programs.)
2. All individuals or groups requesting participation must submit the following for consideration:
 - a. A completed application form.
 - b. A completed Hold-Harmless Waiver.
3. The Village of Mundelein owns and is responsible for the installation and maintenance of the program related signs.
4. Litter includes: General waste material or debris such as, cans, bottles, wrappers, paper products, etc. Litter does not include: Hazardous waste, heavy or large items, animal carcasses, etc. Please contact the Public Works and Engineering Department at (847) 949 – 3270 to arrange for the removal of these items.
5. Litter collection is to be off of the roadway and shoulder. Public Works and Engineering can be contacted for larger items requiring removal from the roadway or shoulder. This removal will be completed during regular business hours.
6. The Village of Mundelein - Public Works and Engineering Department will supply trash/collection bags in bundles of ten (10). Please contact the Public Works and Engineering Department to replenish the supply as needed.
7. The commitment is for a two-year period with a minimum of four (4) collections per year.
8. Participants are not permitted to enter onto private property for collection purposes at any time.
9. All participants are required to wear a reflective safety vest at all times while involved in the collection activity. The vests will be supplied by the Village of Mundelein and are issued by the Public Works and Engineering Department at the initial information and safety meeting.

10. The “Crew Working” folding signs located under the Adopt-A-Roadway signs are to be opened at each end of the collection activity by the participants by removing the securing clips prior to the collection and closed and secured at the completion of the collection period.
11. Participants are required to obey and abide by all laws, regulations and policies while conducting the collection activity.
12. Participants shall not be under the influence of a controlled substance while performing the collection activity. No alcohol or other controlled substance is to be consumed during the collection activity.
13. Participants must be at least 12 years of age. The group must provide one adult supervisor for every 5 youths when persons under the age of 18 are present.
14. All participants must attend an informational and safety meeting prior to each collection, conducted by the group’s coordinator.
15. It is recommended that participants wear gloves and work shoes/boots during collection activities.
16. Participants are recommended to work in threes. Two (2) collecting while the other observes traffic for safety. The assignments can be rotated to provide rest periods.
17. During collections, a cellular phone and first aid kit are recommended for emergency needs.
18. Collection trash bags and any other items are to be placed at least six feet from the roadway for traffic safety considerations.
19. The Public Works and Engineering Department is to be contacted once the collection is complete to arrange for the pick-up of trash bags and collected items the following work day.
20. Conflict shall be avoided at all times with motorists and adjacent property owners. Anyone encountering confrontational situations should contact the Police Department non-emergency number at (847) 968-4600 to report the situation.

**WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT
FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN
ADOPT-A-ROADWAY PROGRAM**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Participating Individual/Organization hereby agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Village of Mundelein, its officials, agents and employees, against all injuries, deaths, loss, damages, claims, suits, liabilities, judgments, cost and expenses (including attorneys fees), which may in anywise accrue against the Village of Mundelein, its officials, agents and employees, arising in consequence of the Participating Individual/Organization participation in the Activity, or which may in anywise result therefore, except that arising out of the sole legal cause of the Village of Mundelein, its agents or employees. The Participating Individual/Organization shall, at its own expense, appear, defend and pay all charges of attorneys and all costs and other expenses arising therefore or incurred in connections therewith, and, if any judgment shall be rendered against the Village of Mundelein, its officials, agents and employees, in any such action, the Participating Individual/Organization at its own expense, satisfy and discharge the same.

By signing this agreement, the undersigned, on behalf of the Participating Individual/Organization, acknowledges that they have read the Adopt-A-Roadway Program and safety guidelines, reviewed the guidelines with other members of organization that will be participating in the Activity and accepts responsibility for assuring that the guidelines are followed.

The invalidity or unenforceability of any of the provisions hereof shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remainder of this Agreement.
