



ELECTRONICS DROP-OFF VILLAGE OF MUNDELEIN

Household electronics recycling drop-off began on May 1 at the Public Works facility, 440 East Crystal Street, and will continue through October 31. Drop-off is available from 8 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. on weekdays and is for Lake County residents only. Materials must be residential in nature. The following are not accepted: Air conditioners, dehumidifiers, large household appliances, batteries, electric fixtures, fluorescent light bulbs, and compact disks. The 2007 Mundelein electronics program was recognized by SWALCO for diverting over 91 tons of materials from area landfills.

Before recycling usable electronic items, please consider donating them to Goodwill, Salvation Army, or another non-profit user. Re-use or “freecycling” is as important as recycling. Visit www.freecycle.org for more information.

The following is a general list of acceptable and not acceptable electronic items.

Accepted Items:

Personal Computers, Monitors, Computer Drives, Keyboards, Modems, Mainframes, Scanners, Printers, PDA Organizers, Cellular Phones, Televisions, Stereos, MP3 Players, CD Players, DVD Players, VCR's, Cameras, Video Games, Fax Machines, Shredders and Small Household Appliances.

Items NOT Accepted:

Broken Glass, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers, Large Household Appliances, Batteries, Electric Fixtures, Fluorescent Light Bulbs, Compact Disks, Software Disks, Tapes, Liquid or Chemical Waste, and Packaging Materials.
