

What is RideLakeCounty | Central?

Residents of Lake County's central townships of Fremont, Libertyville and Shields, including the villages of Libertyville and Mundelein, have Pace curb-to-curb dial-a-ride service within this designated area. Service also extends to the Vernon Hills/Route 60 commercial area, Northwestern and Advocate Condell medical offices in Grayslake, and College of Lake County in Grayslake.

You can go to medical appointments, shop, attend College of Lake County, and access employment...get a ride with RideLakeCounty!

This service is sponsored by the three townships and the villages of Libertyville and Mundelein, with assistance from the Lake County Coordinated Transportation Services Committee (LCCTSC), Lake County, and Pace Suburban Bus. The service is funded in part by grants from the Regional Transportation Authority. Local matching funds for these federal grants are provided by Lake County and Pace Suburban Bus.

Who Is Eligible?



Service is open to seniors (age 60+) and individuals with disabilities who are residents of Fremont, Libertyville and Shields Townships including the villages of Libertyville and Mundelein.

When Can I Ride?



Monday - Friday
5:30am - 6:45pm

No service on these observed holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.

How Do I Schedule A Ride?

- Please call at least 24 hours in advance
- Passengers may make reservations 7 days in advance for work, medical appointments and College of Lake County trips
- Subscription service trips for medical trips only
- If you must cancel, please provide at least 2 hours' notice

How Much Does It Cost?

One-Way Fares *(exact change required):*




- **\$3.00** each way for trips under 10 miles for seniors (age 60+) and disabled
- **\$6.00** each way for trips over 10 miles for disabled and/or senior
- **\$5.00** each way for subscription trips
- **\$0.15** transfer fee *if transferring to other dial-a-ride or ADA Paratransit services*

Where Can I Ride?

Service Area: RideLakeCounty | Central

Eligible residents of Fremont, Libertyville and Shields townships can travel between and within these townships (*highlighted area on map*) and to the additional destinations below:

- College of Lake County, Grayslake
- Greenleaf Avenue Medical Offices
- Lake County Health Department, North Chicago Health Center
- Northwestern Grayslake Outpatient Services
- Vernon Hills/Route 60 shopping area
- Walmart Supercenter, Fountain Square Plaza
- West Lake Forest Metra Station



What Else Should I Know?

- All vehicles are wheelchair accessible
- This is a shared-ride service, the bus will pick up and drop off other passengers
- This is a curb-to-curb service, drivers cannot escort riders outside of the vehicle or carry packages
- Companions are limited to one person or child per registered rider (regular fares apply)
- Riders under age 16 must be accompanied by an adult (regular fares apply)
