I look forward to working with the new Village Board because we have a very fine group of individuals who all share a common goal - a love of this community and a commitment to improving the wonderful quality of life that we enjoy here in Mundelein.

“Quality of life” is not a hollow marketing term. Instead, it is the essential resource of the Village’s well-being and the net result of our great schools, vibrant parks and quality recreational programs, great library with excellent educational programming, fun community events, top notch public infrastructure, and diversity in businesses, housing and people. The Village Board and I are stewards of the public trust and we understand that mutual cooperation, respect and hard work are the traits we will need to keep advancing our quality of life.



The new Village Hall/Weston office building construction is underway. The foundation will be completed by

the end of the month with work on the exterior shell scheduled to start in July. Public improvement work started again in April with streetlights and sidewalks getting installed. Brick paver work will be starting soon. When the additional site work is completed, we will open Chicago Avenue will allow access to the Metra station from Hawley Street.

I am pleased to announce the Board’s approval of an agreement for the second multi-family building in the Cardinal Square Development. Building #2 will be a 65 unit, 5-story apartment building on McKinley Street. The architectural design and high-level of construction quality will be the same as in Building #1. This project will not only raise our tax base and contribute to the TIF District, it will bring new residents to the downtown.

Our recent comprehensive plan recommended that the Village establish a distinct brand that reflects our unique character as well as our community assets. With this in mind, we will soon select a branding consultant to guide us. This process will require much public input. The project excites us and we plan on sharing more about it after it begins in July.

Multi-Family Housing Refuse & Recycling



The Village of Mundelein recently renegotiated the solid waste contract with Groot Industries to include garbage and recycling services for multi-family buildings. The Village shares Lake County's goal of 60% diversion of materials from landfills. This change which became effective May 1st, expands recycling to about 1,200 multi-family households. Multi-family complexes with curbside collection are not included.

The new contract also enables single family homes to switch to a 90 gallon recycling container. To get a new, larger container contact Groot at 847-566-5159. If you switch to the larger recycling container your garbage container will switch to the smaller sized 60 gallon container.

2013 Mundelein Community Days

Mundelein Days will be a 5-day event this year, opening at 5 pm on Wednesday, July 3rd and closing at 7 pm on July 7th. For a full schedule of events see pages 7-10 of this newsletter, or select the Community Days link at www.mundelein.org.

As of this writing, it is likely that the carnival will not be allowed to use the vacant field east of the Santa Maria parking lot. The property is in foreclosure and permission has not been granted by the bank. While there is a small chance permission will be obtained, an alternative layout has been worked out - moving midway games and some rides to Crystal Street.

Musically, the festival features a wide variety of excellent bands. **The Hen-house Prowlers** (traditional Bluegrass) open on Wednesday night, followed by Mundelein's own, **Samadhi Vibe** (blues, rock and funk). On July 4th the music starts at noon, with 3 great, local, acoustic duos under the main tent: the **Apuli Brothers**, **Hudson McCoy**, and **Harry Reinhart/Peter Quinn**. Thursday is Country music night with **Stateline County** (playing current and classic country), then **Bella Cain** playing country with a twist.

Friday kicks off with the **B-Side Band** (rock and soul), followed by **Mike & Joe** (contemporary rock). On Saturday, we switch to a Spanish flair during the day—**Mariachi** first, then the Latin percussion of **Banda Ri-ka**. The night concludes with the high energy music of **Hi-Infidelity**. Mundelein Days wraps up with great blues from the **Rough House Blues Band**.



Aggregated Electricity Rate for Mundelein Customers

Some customers switched to an alternate energy supplier prior to the Village's August 2012 switch to the First Energy Solutions. If you were one of these customers most likely you were not included in the switch to First Energy. You may want to check your rate and determine the contract expiration. It is likely that your rate is higher than aggregated First Energy rate of .0477 cents (.0486 cents for "green" energy) per kilowatt hour. If you choose to switch, call First Energy at 866-636-3749. The aggregated rate remains in effect until August 2014. The second round of municipal aggregation bidding begins in Spring 2014.

Upon the purchase of a new home, it is the responsibility of the new homeowner to call First Energy at 866-636-3749 to enroll at the municipal aggregation rate. Without taking this action, the residence automatically switches to ComEd.

You may receive a phone call from an energy supplier promising to lower your electricity rate if you switch. It is unlikely that the rate will be lower than the aggregated rate. If you choose to switch from First Energy to a new provider, you will be charged a \$25 cancellation fee by First Energy.

The Village has received complaints from customers that are being switched without their authorization. If this happen, call First Energy for an explanation of how you can be switched back and have the cancellation fee waived. Victims of this type of scam, can file a complaint with the Illinois Commerce Commission by calling 1-800-524-0795.

Fire Department

Outdoor Fireplace Safety



The Mundelein Fire Code allows for certain methods of outdoor burning are allowed within the Village. A recreational fire is defined by code as “an outdoor fire utilized to cook food for human consumption, or wood fires burned in metal, or porcelain finished metal, portable outdoor fireplace structures constructed of brick or stone.” Such recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of any structure or combustible materials, and only in backyards, the use in front of a

house is prohibited. All such fires shall be contained within one of the above approved devices. Portable outdoor fireplaces shall be used only on noncombustible surfaces. Fuel for an outdoor fireplace shall consist of only seasoned, dry firewood and shall be ignited with a small quantity of paper.

Materials not allowed to burn in such fireplaces include but is not limited to leaves, paper, plywood, construction materials and trash. Ultimately if your fire produces a large amount of smoke, which affects your neighbors, you may be required to extinguish it. As with any open flame device, close adult supervision is extremely important. These fireplaces should never be left unattended for any length of time. Extinguishment of the contents of the fireplace should be completed prior to terminating its use. If you have any questions, call the Fire Department at 847-949-3260.

Sky Lanterns Banned

Recently the Office of the State Fire Marshal placed “Sky Lanterns” on the “Prohibited Consumer Fireworks” list.

Sky lanterns, or as they are sometimes called, Floating Lanterns, Wishing Lanterns and Celebrations Lanterns are airborne paper lanterns. The lanterns contain a small candle or fuel cell when lit, which heats the air in the lantern making it rise into the air. They are known to travel up to several miles away from where they were originally released.



Based on this determination by the Office of the State Fire Marshal, these devices will be illegal to use in Mundelein and will not be permitted to be sold in retail establishments. They are readily available on the internet and the purchase and use through that method is also prohibited. The safety of our citizens is one of our key missions and we want to make sure that any celebration is an enjoyable one. SAFETY CHECK:

Power Attic Fans

In the past the Village has experienced house fires in conjunction with the operation of powered attic ventilators, we would like to recommend that the following steps be taken before use:

Be sure wiring meets code requirements for this type of use.

Make sure all electrical connections are tight.

Check for overloading of electrical circuit that the ventilator is on.

Before operating a power ventilator, visually check that the fan blades turn and do not bind up.

When first powered up, visually check if it is operating properly. If the fan does not turn properly, do not use the ventilator.

If the ventilator is thermostatically controlled, check the owner’s manual for proper temperature setting of the thermostat.

If you should have any other questions, contact the manufacturer of the ventilator or your heating and air conditioning service provider.

ACCREDITATION ASSESSMENT ~ JULY 29TH

The Mundelein Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment to maintain its accreditation. The assessment verifies that the department continues to meet professional standards. The assessment is administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA). The program requires compliance with state-of-the-art standards in a range of Law Enforcement functions including: policies and procedures, administration, operations and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a Public Information Hearing on Monday, July 29, 2013, between the hours of 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team. Telephone comments as well as appearances at the Public Information Hearing are limited to 10 minutes and must address the agency's ability to comply with CALEA's standards. A copy of the Standards is available at the Mundelein Police Department, please contact Deputy Chief John Monahan or Commander Mike Richards. Anyone wishing to submit written comment about the Police Department's ability to comply with the Standards for Accreditation may send them to the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. Cops and Bobbers July 13



The Police Department's 16th annual Cops "n" Bobbers fishing derby will be on Saturday, July 13, 2013 from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. at Noll Park, Huntington Drive and Hampton Lane. Parents bring your kids ages 5 – 13 and their fishing poles and spend the morning fishing. The derby is a great chance for families to interact with Police officers.

The pond will be stocked with fish and bait will be provided by the Country Corner store.

ILDNR will have a few fishing poles available. There will be a raffle drawing and prizes for biggest fish, smallest fish and most fish. There is no charge to participate; first 100 children will get a free t-shirt. Food and non-alcoholic beverages are allowed in the park, feel free to bring a picnic lunch. Curfews for Youth

Curfew hours for children under 17 years old are Sunday - Thursday from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Saturday and Sunday from midnight to 6 a.m. In addition, drivers under 18 may not operate a motor vehicle between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, and between 11 p.m. and 6 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

Fireworks

While fireworks are very popular they are also dangerous. The Police Department vigorously enforces the local fireworks statutes related to the illegal possession and discharge of fireworks. Possession of fireworks in excess of 1 pound is a Class A misdemeanor. The discharge of a firework in the Village without a permit is prohibited. It's important to note that fireworks such as firecrackers, bottle rockets and Roman candles, are not allowed in Illinois under the new State regulations.

SELF DEFENSE FOR WOMEN

The Police Department is offering a defense class for women ages 18 and up (exceptions will be made for 17 year olds with parental permission). Waiver release required for all participants. Building Department

Grass Maintenance

A reminder that the Village has an ordinance that requires grass and weeds to be maintained less than eight inches in height. Keeping the grass and weeds maintained helps the overall look of your neighborhood and for the community. Please do your part in keeping up the appearance of your community by maintaining your lawn.

Vacant and abandoned properties can become a real problem for the community if left unsecured and unmaintained. Many times the neighbors will cut the grass and do basic maintenance on a vacant property just to keep up the appearance of their neighborhood. Banks and lending institutions are not necessarily the owners, and generally are not responsible for the condition of the property.

If you have a property in your neighborhood that appears to have long grass, please contact the Building Department at 847-949-3283 or building@mundelein.org. An inspector will be dispatched the following day to follow up on the possible violation. For vacant or abandoned property, they will be inspected and processes put into place to get the property maintained and secured. This process can take time, there are numerous steps the Village must take before we can trespass on someone's property and perform the work.

Homeowners can reduce energy costs and make their homes more comfortable, by sealing air leaks and properly insulating their attics while allowing proper ventilation.

Energy Impact Illinois, a program funded by the U.S. Department of Energy and utility companies, is making this process easy for homes of all sizes and homeowners of all income levels by providing \$99 energy assessments and rebates up to \$1,750 on air sealing and insulation.

Public Works and Engineering

2013 Street Program

This year, the Village's annual street program will be focused in Loch Lomond, Cambridge Country and Cambridge West subdivisions. The Loch Lomond reconstruction work will include some utility improvements, while the Cambridge Country and Cambridge West work will concentrate on rehabilitation of the concrete roads. The streets targeted for improvement include:



Dunbar Road (Banbury - Route 45)
Dunleer Drive (Dunbar - Dairy)
Dairy Lane (Dunleer - Dunbar)
Albion Lane (Bingham - Stafford)
Stafford Drive (Albion - Eddington)
Eaton Way (Sandhurst - Huntington)
Bedford Road (Huntington - Knightsbridge)
Sandhurst Road (Bedford - Bedford)



Work will include full depth concrete roadway patching and milling with asphalt overlay, sidewalk replacement, and minor storm sewer improvements. The project is to be completed by the end of October and includes parkway restoration. If you have questions or concerns call Public Works at 847-949-3270.

Emerald Ash Borer Program

The Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) has a confirmed presence in the Village; about 132 Right-of-Way ash trees will be selectively removed and replaced this spring. The Village received a \$20,000 EPA grant.

The EAB is small, green and metallic and only infests ash trees. If your ash tree is demonstrating signs of EAB infestation, please contact Public Works at 847-949-3270. Infested parkway trees will be removed by the Village. Private tree owners should promptly remove or treat infested ash trees at their own expense. Sawvell Tree Service, will provide residents with the same pricing as the Village receives for removals of accessible ash trees. Private ash tree owners should weigh the cost of treatment over a number of years versus removal and planting a suitable replacement.

Lawn sprinkling restrictions are

in effect May through September. The sprinkling or watering of trees, sod, bushes, shrubs, flowers, gardens, etc., from the municipal water supply. **Watering is permitted between 5 a.m. and 10 a.m., or 6 p.m. and 11 p.m. East of Route 45 on even calendar days, West of Route 45 on odd calendar days.**

Other outdoor water use is permitted at any time providing a hose with a shut-off nozzle is used. Newly planted landscaping may be watered at any time on the day of installation. Thereafter, newly planted landscaping may be watered on any day, but only during the permitted hours for up to three weeks from date of planting.

Mosquito Control

The Village uses Clarke Environmental for mosquito control. Services include treating breeding areas, public and private catch basin applications and monitoring nuisance levels. Residents who have a breeding area on their property should call the mosquito hotline at 1-800-942-2555. The area will then be checked and treated as needed. When it is determined that there is an outbreak of adult mosquitoes, a Village-wide ULV spray will be ordered.



1ST ANNUAL COMMERCIAL BROKERS MEETING

EDC Hosts Event to Promote Development Opportunity

The Village of Mundelein Economic Development Commission hosted 40 participants for its 1st Annual Commercial Real Estate Brokers Meeting on June 5th. Mayor Steve Lentz welcomed brokers and business managers from the Chicago area to the event, which highlighted construction activities and available business opportunities. "Mundelein is open for business", the Mayor announced, "For years we have been laying a foundation for business growth that we are certain will enhance economic growth. We want you to know about our progress and invite you to participate", he added.

Village Administrator John Lobaito highlighted a variety of development opportunities that have been created by the Village over the past eight years through land acquisitions, formation of a TIF district, and master planning. "We have set a steady course for long-term economic growth", Mr. Lobaito said. Adding that, "A lot of planning and hard work, has been devoted to transforming our Downtown into a vibrant, attractive, transit-oriented, multi-use amenity".

Scott Springer, Vice President of Weston Solutions, the Village's private sector partner on the downtown redevelopment, explained the basic components of his company's Public Private Partnership with the Village. Mr. Springer noted that the investment his company is making in Mundelein is based on solid economic analysis, realistic planning, and excellent cooperation with the Village Board and Staff. Weston Solutions, Mr. Springer noted, will lease 15,000 square feet of space in the new Village Hall, currently under construction.

Bridget Lane of Business Development, Inc. underscored the favorable demographics and excellent location of downtown Mundelein, noting that it is within a five-minute drive time of households with an income above \$110,000. There is a daytime population within the Downtown of over 7,000. Additionally, the population within a fifteen-minute drive time is over 186,000. The Village is also within a fifteen-minute drive of the Tri-State Tollway.

The Village now provides residents with access to interactive GIS (Governmental Information Systems) maps containing detailed property information via the Village website.

To view the maps, visit www.mundelein.org. Look for the icon (shown above), which will link you to “Interactive Village Maps”. The icon is located in the lower left corner of the Village home page. At this site you can quickly access a host of customized tools and property information. You can look up information on any property in the Village, including refuse and recycling pick-up days, school districts, polling locations and tax information. Maps showing school, library and park district boundaries, election precincts, legislative districts have just been added to the site. The program also allows measuring of a given distance.

In the upper right-hand corner of the site you can select an option for “aerial photos”, “terrain maps” and “layers”, which provides a drop down menu to select district, precinct and legislative maps. Also included is a tutorial guide and instructional video option available to help you maneuver through the site. As new maps and informational databases are developed they will be added to the site. Please check the site periodically for updates.

TORNADO APPLICATION AVAILABLE

The American Red Cross has developed an official Tornado application (app) for smartphones and tablets. The Tornado app sounds an alarm when NOAA issues a tornado warning for your location, even when the app is closed. In addition, the app puts everything you need to know to prepare for an impending tornado in the palm of your hand. This app may serve as a great tool for responders from all disciplines.



The Tornado app is available through the Village website (www.mundelein.org) under the Police Department.

The tornado warning app puts everything you need to know to prepare for a tornado – and all that comes with it – in the palm of your hand. With interactive quizzes and simple step-by-step advice; it’s never been easier to be ready.

The application also features:

- Step-by-step instructions to help you know what to do even if the cell towers and TVs are not operating.

- Prioritized actions for before, during, and after requires no mobile connectivity.

- Audible siren that automatically goes off even if app is closed when the National Oceanic and Atmosphere Administration (NOAA) issues a tornado warning.

- Push notification sent when a warning expires – especially important if power goes out while you or your family are in your safe room.

- Red Cross location-based open shelters map for when you need it most.
