Message From the Mayor

It's summer, and once again we can enjoy the Farmers Market, Barefoot Bay, Park on Park, Summer Concert Series, and our gorgeous golf courses to name just a few!

Recently, Mundelein hosted the Third Annual Craft Beer Festival and the event drew over 1,700 people, our largest crowd to date! I am very proud that Mundelein has earned the reputation of hosting one of the finest craft beer festivals in the area. Special thanks to Bruce Dir of Tighthead Brewery and our own Mundelein Community Connection for all they did to make this happen.

Mark your calendars! A complete schedule of our upcoming **Mundelein Community Days** is in this newsletter. Every year this is our most attended event and a wonderful way to celebrate the 4th of July.

Business Incentives: You spoke, and we are listening. The Board of Trustees recently approved a \$100,000 expansion to our grant program to encourage businesses to invest in their properties to improve the overall appearance of our Village. Under this program, storefronts in downtown and throughout the Village could get facelifts, refurbish facades, sign replacement, certain interior upgrades, and other eligible projects funded in part with a monetary grant from the Village. It's meant to encourage businesses to move into Mundelein and to help existing businesses flourish.

Would you please help us spread the word regarding this grant money? Since the program began over a year ago, only two businesses have applied-for, and received,

matching grant funds for their improvements: Luke's of Mundelein and Best Car Care. We encourage businesses seeking to make aesthetic improvements to apply for this grant money.

Our Economic Development Commission is helping with this, but you can too! Please mention this to business owners you know and, if they are interested, ask them to call Victor Barrera, our Director of Community Development, at 847-949-3282.

SAIA Truck Terminal: You may have noticed all of the activity just north of Winchester, off of Midlothian. Here's what's happening. Last year, the Village Board of Trustees voted to file a lawsuit and oppose the proposed land use on the former Roppelt farm—a 33-acre parcel of land for SAIA Freight located north of Winchester Road, south of Petersen Road, parallel to Midlothian Road on the west side and recently annexed into the Village of Grayslake. The Board strongly opposes a 24-hour trucking terminal on this property due to the negative impact it will have on our residents. Additionally, this land use is inconsistent with surrounding land uses. Although we filed this lawsuit to protect our residents and to stop this specific land use, **SAIA Freight is proceeding with the**

Mundelein Trustees Approve \$100,000 Expanded Business Grant Program Aimed at Revitalization Efforts throughout Village

In support of an ongoing initiative to revitalize Mundelein's downtown and beyond, Mundelein's Board of Trustees recently adopted a policy to approve the much anticipated expanded business grant program aimed at helping business owners and those interested in investing in Mundelein.

Under this expanded business grant program, storefronts in downtown Mundelein and throughout the Village could get facelifts, refurbish facades, sign replacement, certain interior upgrades, and other eligible projects funded in part by the Village's pockets. Business owners and prospective businesses will have access to \$100,000 in grant funds. \$75,000 is earmarked for business improvements and \$25,000 for signage upgrades. The overarching goal is to funnel money into projects that freshen up properties on a larger scale than routine maintenance. Additionally, the business grant program is designed to promote business investment, facilitate the creation of jobs, and enhance the quality of life in Mundelein through business attraction and expansion.

"Our expanded business grant program is another tangible step we are taking to be business friendly. We want to do whatever we can to encourage business owners to invest in their property and make necessary renovations that could generate a buzz that attracts new shoppers and developers who want to do business in Mundelein. Plus, we hope that once residents see business owners making enhancements to their properties, residents will feel compelled to do the same. Also, the Village wants to expand the commercial/industrial property tax base and sales tax base to reduce its reliance on residential property taxes," explains Village Administrator John Lobaito.

Mundelein's expanded business grant program closely supports the Village's brand promise—"Mundelein will be central Lake County's premier location for entrepreneurs and known

as a welcoming community." Indeed, to communicate a welcoming image, Mundelein's public infrastructure needs to be enhanced.



HERE IS A SUMMARY OF MUNDELEIN'S EXPANDED \$100,000 BUSINESS GRANT PROGRAM RECENTLY APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

Commercial Improvement Grant Program

- Monies are available for exterior or interior enhancements or upgrades.
- Exterior improvements must be visible from the public right of way.
- Possible interior upgrades include: electrical, plumbing, mechanical hood and duct equipment.
- Village pays 50% of the improvement costs, up to a maximum of \$25,000.
- There is a payback provision if the business closes within 3 years, however, after three years, no payback required.

- All projects are subject to Village Board approval and must meet established goals.

Sign Grant Program

- Funding available to assist business owners bring signs into compliance with new sign ordinance.
- The Village will fund 50% of the improvement costs, up to a maximum of \$5,000.
- Projects are subject to Village Board approval.

Mundelein Youth Sports Organizations Partner with Nationally Renowned Positive Coaching Alliance


Recently, the Mundelein Baseball and Softball Association (MBSA) and the Mundelein-based Lake County Stallions (LCS) joined forces to form an unprecedented partnership with the Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA), a national non-profit organization that helps coaches and parents provide a positive experience for youth athletes and the community. The program promotes positive reinforcement and character-building as a means to help kids compete at a high level.

In an effort to introduce Mundelein parents to the organization's cutting edge approach to character building through athletics, the MBSA and the LCS invites Mundelein parents to a FREE workshop introducing the Positive Coaching Alliance program and the key role parents play in teaching positive life lessons through sports. **The workshop will be held in the Carmel Catholic High School Auditorium on June 30 from 7-9 p.m.** Parents are invited to kick off the event with complimentary pizza and soft drinks at 6:30 p.m. All current and prospective youth sports parents are welcome to attend.

MBSA President Kevin McKay says it's vital that parents understand the PCA approach so the community can make the most out of the partnership.

If our parents know what PCA is about, they can help us maintain a positive youth sports culture that everyone in Mundelein can be proud of – one that serves as a model to surrounding communities."

As leaders, it's important that we give our volunteer coaches the tools they need to help our kids grow up to be winners in life. We're confident PCA will help us do that."



Building Department Offers Tips and Suggestions for Successful Home Improvement Projects

Mundelein's Building Department, under the direction of Pete Schubkegel, offers residents some tips and steps that should be taken to ensure better outcomes when entering into contracts for home repair and improvement projects.

Home Repair Checklist

- Get all estimates and warranties in writing.
- Do not be induced by high pressure sales tactics, such as special prices if you sign a contract today.
- Take time to check references. Ask for at least 3 references – one for a project that is current or recently completed. Another completed about a year ago and one from at least 2-3 years ago. Call these references and ask how satisfied they were with the workmanship, if work was completed in the estimated time, and if any warranty work was required.
- Check with the Better Business Bureau regarding any complaints. Access their website <http://chicago.bbb.org>
- Never sign a contract with blank spaces or one that you do not fully understand. If you are taking a loan to finance the work, do not sign the contract before lender approves it. Important: Mail signed contract to contractor's address and verify receipt.
- You have 3 business days from the time you sign to cancel any contract if the sale is made at your home. The contractor cannot deprive you of this right by initiating work, selling your contract to a lender, or any other tactic.
- Ask your contractor if they are registered with the Village. Call the Building Department at 847-949-3283 to verify registration. You must provide the Building Department a brief description of the proposed project to determine whether a



permit is required. If a permit is required, you or your contractor must obtain and post it in plain view prior to commencing any work.

Basic Terms to be Included in a Contract:

- Contractor's full name, address, and telephone number. Illinois law requires that persons selling home repair and improvement services provide their customers with notice of any change to their business name or address that occurs prior to the agreed dates for beginning or completing the work.
- A description of all work to be performed.
- Starting and estimated completion dates.
- Total cost of work to be performed.
- Schedule and method of payment, including down payment, subsequent payments, and final payment. Important: Owner should request material and labor waivers for work performed when requested to make subsequent payments. You should always receive final waivers for labor and for all materials delivered to your home from non-contracted sources such as ready-mix, lumber, roofing suppliers, etc. when making final payments. The waivers serve as proof that payment

was made by your contractor for all labor and materials used on your project and will protect you from liens against your property.

- A provision stating grounds for termination of the contract by either party. The homeowner must pay the contractor for any work completed. If the contractor fails to commence or complete work within the contracted time period, the homeowner may cancel and be entitled to a refund of any down payment or other payments made toward the work upon written demand by certified mail.
- Always keep a copy of the signed contract in a safe place for reference as needed.
- It is important that you know your consumer rights in regard to home repairs.






Mundelein Families Invited to Police Department's Annual Cops N' Bobbers Fishing Derby



Residents Beware! Recent Scams Cause Police Department to Offer Warnings

Problem– Residents are receiving telephone calls from someone claiming to be from the internal revenue Service (IRS) threatening to have them arrested, deported, or revoking their business and/or driver's license if immediate payment is not made.

Solution– Never wire money to anyone, person or business, unless their identity has been confirmed and it is not ordinary. Contact the police department if in doubt.

Problem– Law Enforcement Solicitation of Money (i.e. Fraternal Order of Police) – Residents may receive a telephone call from someone claiming to be from the Fraternal Order of Police, or another law enforcement agency, soliciting funds.

Solution– Call the local police department and verify its legitimacy. Never provide social security numbers, credit card or banking information over the phone.

Important Security Reminders to Keep Residents Safe, Possessions Protected

The Mundelein Police Department encourages residents to be mindful of important security measures to be taken in neighborhoods, homes and automobiles. Residents must be diligent in locking up cars, garages, and residences. Do not leave laptops, cell phones and other expensive equipment in your automobile which would be visible to the passerby. Be sure to report any suspicious behavior or people in your neighborhood. The non-emergency phone number to the Police Department is 847-968-4600 and call 911 in an emergency.
