**SAIA
 Trucking
 Facility
 Lawsuit**

Recently, the Board of Trustees authorized the filing of an appeal regarding the Mundelein vs. SAIA Motor Freight Line/Grayslake lawsuit. The Board felt compelled to pursue this course of action due to the long-term financial and environmental implications to the community from a trucking facility located directly next to an established residential neighborhood. These concerns primarily center on noise, truck traffic, diesel fuel pollution, and diminished property values associated with a 24/7 industrial operation. The investment we have made related to the SAIA lawsuit pales in comparison to the long-term financial implications to the community once the SAIA truck terminal is fully operational.

Mike Flynn, Assistant Village Administrator for the Village of Mundelein, recently retired after nearly three decades of dedicated and meritorious service to Mundelein. He was honored at a Retirement Celebration held at the Double Tree Hotel in Mundelein.

According to Village Administrator, John Lobaito, as a result of Mike’s diligent work and demonstrated abilities, he advanced to positions of increasing responsibilities and throughout his many years of service, he served his colleagues and residents with fairness and dedication, further, he earned the respect and admiration of management and co-workers for his knowledge, efficiency, and humor.

“I often said that we cannot just ‘replace a Mike Flynn.’ He was a generalist in every sense of the word. He was able to excel at every task assigned to him and he tackled problems with tenacity and with a smile on his face. I could always count on Mike to give me his honest opinion whenever I sought his counsel. I am grateful for his significant contributions to Mundelein and his legacy will endure for decades,” Lobaito said.

“Mike’s general concern for the well-being of residents, Village staff, and members of the Board, reflected his abiding respect for everyone with whom he came in contact; and his rare combination of technical expertise made him a unique asset to the Village. He will be greatly missed but we wish Mike and his family all the best as he ventures onward to the next stage of his life. On behalf of the Board of Trustees, we extend to Mike our heartfelt thanks for a job well done,” said Steve Lentz, Mayor.

Over the course of Mike’s 29 years with the Village of Mundelein he served under four Mayors: Colin McRae, Marilyn Sindles, Ken Kessler, and Steve Lentz.

During Mike’s tenure, Mundelein has grown and evolved. A few of the most noteworthy changes include:

- Storm water control
- Commuter rail service
- Facility improvements including: Waste Water Treatment Plant, 2 fire stations, Police Station, and the Village Hall.

Mundelein Trustees Approve FY18 Budget

The Mundelein Board of Trustees recently approved the Fiscal Year 2018 \$49,310,774 budget, a \$5.5 million or 11% decrease from the FY2016-17 budget of \$54,853,809. The General Corporate Fund has budgeted revenues of \$26,500,000 and budgeted expenditures of \$26,500,000, a 1.9% increase from the prior year. There is a 2.5% Cost of Living Adjustment and a \$400,000 addition to Mundelein's Road and Bridge Fund to address Village infrastructure. The FY2017-18 Budget allocates \$12 million for Village-wide capital improvement projects. The new fiscal year begins May 1, 2017.

The FY2017-18 budget also includes \$200,000 for the removal of about 200 parkway trees damaged by emerald ash borers. These are the last of about 1,900 ash trees to be destroyed by the Village as part of a program that began in 2013. The budget also increases funding for Mundelein's Business Incentive Grant (BIG) program which is designed to assist local businesses or commercial landlords improve the aesthetics of their buildings. Mundelein officials have set aside \$125,000 for the effort, up from \$100,000.

According to projections, The Village will collect about \$46 million in property taxes, fees, and other revenue over the next year. This represents a slight increase from the \$44 million predicted for the current year.

"I want to acknowledge Village Administrator John Lobaito and Chief Financial Officer Doug Haywood for the time and effort they invested into the budget process. I am pleased with the budget we presented to the Board and I'm looking forward to another productive year in terms of infrastructure improvements and economic development," said Steve Lentz, Mayor.

The Village of Mundelein will increase Water/Sewer rates with an effective date for bills issued on June 1. There will be a \$0.32 increase to the annualized unit price, adding \$11.52 annually for the minimum water user (6 units). Mundelein bills water in units and not gallons. A unit is approximately 750 gallons.

The water rate increase is part of a planned increase to generate necessary revenue to fund capital improvements to the system. The rate increase is as follows: Proposed minimum water user \$52.32 per bi-monthly bill (\$51.72 in summer, \$52.92 in

non-summer); Current minimum user \$50.40 per bi-monthly bill (\$49.44 in summer, \$50.64 in non-summer). Current annualized rate \$8.40 per 750 gallons (\$8.24 summer, \$8.44 non-summer), proposed \$8.72 annualized (\$8.62 summer, \$8.82 non-summer).

"Mundelein's budget addresses the most pressing needs of the community—improving public infrastructure, expanding our grant program, and enhancing our brand with new gateway signage. We have a strong sense of fiscal accountability to the taxpayers and drafted the budget in this manner. Spending is decreasing because we completed this year two large and costly road projects—the widening of Hawley Street and improvements to the 60/83 and Route 176 intersection," explained John Lobaito, Village Administrator.

Helpful Tips, Reminders from Mundelein's Plumbing Inspector

It's summer time again, a good time to check your sump pump and clean the sump pit so you are prepared for heavy rains. To check the pit one would need a powerful flash light, bucket and a scooper. (Cut a milk jug in half keep the top part with the handle it makes a good scooper that you can throw away when done.) You want to look down through the water and see if there is any dirt or rocks that have settled in, if so they need to be removed a clean pit will increase your pump life. Remember not to push the dirt and rocks into the pump and always flush afterwards with a garden hose to test the system when finished.

If you have a battery backup sump pump system it's always good on a heavy rain to unplug the electric on the main pump and unplug the charging system on the backup pump sit back grab some cheese and wine and watch the water level turn the back-up on and off. Remember that the water level will rise higher in the sump pit when the back-up is activated

his way you will know if the system is in good working order and if not you can plug everything back in because you just simulated a power outage or broken sump pump.



In total, the Mundelein received \$7,777. These funds will be used to remove all remaining ash trees and plant new trees throughout Mundelein. The Great Lakes Restoration Initiative seeks to improve the urban forest within the Lake Michigan Watershed. The loss of millions of ash trees in the Lake Michigan Watershed has drawn attention to the need to expand species diversity in tree planting.
