


It's an exciting time to be in Mundelein.



Let's support our local businesses whenever possible. The Village of Mundelein generated over **\$500 million** in retail sales in 2018 representing over **\$8.7 million dollars** in sales tax revenues. If just half of Mundelein's population spent \$50 each month at Mundelein's businesses, their purchases would generate more than \$9 million per year in sales for area businesses, and nearly **\$200,000 in sales tax revenues** for the Village.

## Water/Sewer Rates

*Effective June 1, 2019*

A **Minimum Bill (6 units)** is charged to all accounts each billing period to partially cover fixed costs of operations. The current billing period is indicated by the service dates on the bill front. One billing unit is equivalent to 100 cubic feet or approximately 750 gallons.

The **Storm Water Fee** is a new flat utility fee in 2019 that will be used to mitigate flooding uses throughout the Village and maintain our stormwater system. The fee is based on parcel size, with the minimum set at \$3 per month, or \$6 per bi-monthly bill. A **\$5.00 account set-up fee** will be charged to all new accounts on the first bill.

**Senior Citizen Discount** is \$16.00 per billing period if usage is 15 units or less. Persons 65 years or older, living within the Village of Mundelein, may qualify for this discount. Applications for the Senior Citizen Discount may be obtained from the Customer Service office or online at [www.mundelein.org](http://www.mundelein.org).



## Initial Payment

Once your completed enrollment application is received, it will undergo a "pre-notification" process where a test transaction (zero dollars) is created and used to verify the accuracy of the account information provided. Should the pre-notification test fail (incorrect account number or transit routing number) you will be notified and asked to provide corrected information prior to beginning automatic payments. Each pre-notification test takes approximately 30 days to complete. You will know that automatic payments are scheduled to begin when your monthly bill indicates "Main Line Pay."

Your monthly bank statement will indicate the amount and date of your automatic transfer. Retain this record as proof of payment for future reference regarding your billing. ## Village of Mundelein Electric Aggregation Program Seeks Lower Energy Bids

After seeking competitive bids again, the Village accepted a bid from Constellation Energy Services to restart its program at meter read dates. The rate is fixed at 7.499¢ per kWh for a 24-month term ending at meter readings in October 2020.

All residents and small commercial retail accounts located within the Village limits will automatically be enrolled unless the accountholder:

1. Chooses to opt out as directed in the opt out notice; or
2. Has already switched to another Supplier; or
3. Is a participant in the Residential Real-Time Pricing (RRTP) hourly-rate program

There is no enrollment fee and no early termination fee to vacate the program at any time. Residents will continue to receive one bill from ComEd to include the electric supply charges from Constellation. ComEd will continue to charge for delivery. The way you pay your bill, such as budget billing or automatic payment, will not be affected.

## Solid Waste & Recycling Program

- Residential customers have reduced rates on recycling services, effective October, 2016.
- A limited refuse, reduced price, collection program is available to those who produce less weekly garbage.
- Residents now have access to an optional program that allows for the collection of food scrap compost.
- Weekly collection and recycling program for electronic waste is now available at no additional charge. Residents must contact Groot for collection.

### **Unlimited Standard Refuse Service - \$22.92/Month**

Service includes weekly collection of unlimited household garbage with a 95-gallon cart. One bulk item (non-appliance) will be collected each week for no additional charge. Refuse is required to be out by 6 a.m. each week.

### **Limited Refuse Service - \$18.84/Month**

Service includes the weekly collection limited to one 65-gallon cart and one bulk item, non-appliance, per week. Additional refuse found outside the cart will require one prepaid refuse sticker (\$2.70) to be affixed to each container or bag not to exceed 33-gallons. Please be aware that if you put out more than 1 additional bag per month the unlimited rate will be more cost effective.

### **Pay-Per-Bag Refuse Program - \$2.70 per sticker and \$8.01/Month**

Service requires that one prepaid refuse sticker be affixed to each for weekly collection. Each container or bag is not to exceed 50 pounds. Service includes a 65-gallon cart. Please note, if you generate more than one bag of refuse per week, the standard level of service will be more cost effective.

### **Senior Unlimited Program - \$20.63/Month**

To receive the senior discount residents must be 65 years old or older and registered with the Village for the water bill discount. Service will include weekly collection of one 35-gallon cart for refuse and one 35-gallon cart for recycling.

### **Senior Limited Program - \$16.96/Month**

The senior discount residents must be 65 years old or older and registered with the Village for the water bill discount. Service will include weekly limited collection of one 35-gallon cart for refuse only. Additional refuse found outside the cart will require one prepaid refuse sticker (\$2.70 each) to be affixed to each container or bag not to exceed 33 gallons. Seniors also will receive a 35-gallon cart for recycling.

## Solid Waste & Recycling Program

### Recycling

The Groot refuse programs for Mundelein include a 65-gallon cart for recycling with an option to upgrade a 95-gallon recycling cart, please contact Groot customer service directly at 877-404-7668.

### Appliances

White goods such as refrigerators, ovens, window and central air conditioners, humidifiers, dryers, water heaters, dishwashers, furnaces, and the like, require a special pick-up and separate disposal required by State law. A fee is charged per item for collection. Residents must call and schedule a pick-up in advance.

### Bulk Item Disposal

Service includes collection of one (1) bulk item (non-appliance) per week at no additional cost. For additional bulk items, residents should call Groot to schedule a pick-up and make payment arrangements.

**Bulk items include:** boxes, barrels, crates, furniture, and similar items that do not fit into a proper container and can be collected/lifted by one driver without assistance. Exceptions include items which are banned from direct disposal into a landfill.

**Oversized and Overweight Items:** Any single large or extra heavy item that requires us to schedule a special pick-up to remove will require a special quote from Groot. Residents are required to call and schedule a pick-up in advance. Examples of an oversized item are a large screen television, piano or any item, over 50 lbs., that requires two people to lift.

**Construction Demolition Debris:** All material must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length and no larger than 2 feet in diameter. All debris must be bagged or bundled not exceeding 50 pounds. Residents need to call Groot to obtain price quote and to schedule pick-up for quantities larger than 50 lbs.

**E-Waste Collection:** Under the Illinois Electronic Products Recycling and Reuse Act, no person may knowingly cause or allow the mixing of any electronic items, such as computers, mice, printers, scanners, televisions, digital converter boxes, keyboards, cable receivers, fax machines, etc. with municipal waste that is intended for disposal at a landfill. Groot now collects electronic waste at the curb at NO ADDITIONAL CHARGE. Residents wishing to recycle such items should call Groot to schedule a date and time for collection.

Please note that some items such as large TV's that require more than one person to collect may require an additional fee as determined by Groot personnel.

## Single-Sort Recycling Program

Recyclable materials are collected on your primary day of service. Recyclable materials do not need to be separated. Recyclables are separated at Groot's automated recycling facility.

**Please do NOT place garbage in recycling cart. Also please rinse all items to remove food residue. The collector is trained to check the contents of the cart. If there are foreign materials present, the cart will be left with a tag.**

Please combine the following recyclable materials in the recycling cart:

Glass, Metal, Plastics (i.e., pop bottles, milk jugs)

As well as all containers labeled as follows:

- Aluminum Cans
- Metal Cans
- Steel Cans
- Tin Cans
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Foil and Foil Trays
- Glass Bottles and Jars (clear and all colors)

Groot encourages you to use paper grocery bags in which to place your paper. Do not place any recyclables in plastic bags.

# Solid Waste & Recycling Program

## Landscape Waste

Residents have two options for yard waste collection:

**1. Landscape Waste Stickers:** Residents who have limited volumes of yard waste will have the option to purchase a sticker in which to affix on either a biodegradable yard waste can or bag not exceeding 33-gallons. Stickers will be available for \$2.70 each at the following locations:

- Jewel Food Store, 1501 S. Lake Street
- Ace Hardware, 609 E. Hawley Street
- Village Hall, 300 Plaza Circle
- True Value, 516 N. Seymour Avenue
- Ace Hardware, 155 Peterson Road
- Walgreens, 951 N. Highway 83

**2. Landscape Waste Subscription Service:** Residents who generate higher volumes of yard waste will have the option to sign-up for the subscription program. The program allows up to 4 biodegradable bags or cans not exceeding 33-gallons of yard waste per week from April through November. To receive this service residents must call Groot and subscribe for the 2019 season in the amount of \$108.26.

Tree limbs, branches or bush must be cut to no more than 4 feet in length, bundled no greater than 1 foot in diameter and not to exceed 50 pounds each.

## Leaf Collection Services

As provided in the past, Groot will continue to offer leaf collection services each fall. The schedule shall be outlined through notification by the Village. Groot asks that residents rake all leaves intended for collection within 4 feet of the curb. **Do not place leaves in the street.**

## Food Scrap Collection-Starting April 2017

Mundelein residents will be permitted to place approved food scrap materials inside their landscape bags and containers. Collection will occur on your normal landscape pick-up day.

Mundelein's recycling program is designed to help residents reduce the amount of garbage sent to area landfills. Biodegradable food waste is permitted to be mixed with yard waste as a part of this program that includes the following items:

### YES

- Fruits
- Vegetables
- Breads, grains
- Pasta, cereal
- Dairy (no liquids) – Cottage Cheese, Sour Cream, Yogurt, Butter
- Egg shells
- Coffee grounds and tea leaves

### NO

- Teabags, and coffee filters
- Meat, poultry or seafood (no shells or bones)
- Paper products (paper towels, plates, napkins, egg cartons, pizza boxes)
- Glass, Plastics or Styrofoam
- Diapers, Pet Litter or Waste
- Liquids, Grease or Oil
